SurveyUSA interviewed 1,000 registered voters from North Carolina's 9th Congressional District 03/09/18 through 03/13/18, exclusively for the Civitas Institute. Of the registered voters, 575 were determined by SurveyUSA to be likely to vote in North Carolina's May 8 primary election. Of the likely voters, SurveyUSA determined 375 to be likely to vote in the Republican primary. This research was conducted using blended sample, mixed mode. Respondents reachable on a home telephone (58% of registered voters) were interviewed on their home telephones in the recorded voice of a professional announcer, using Registration-list Based Sample (RBS) from Aristotle of Washington, DC. Respondents not reachable on a home telephone (42% of registered voters) were shown a questionnaire on the display of their smartphone, tablet or other electronic device.
