In Georgia, Chambliss Well Positioned to Hold US Senate Seat; McCain To Paint 15 Electoral Votes Red: In an election for United States Senator from Georgia today, 09/18/08, seven weeks till votes are counted, incumbent Republican Senator Saxby Chambliss defeats Democrat Jim Martin and Libertarian Allen Buckley, according to a SurveyUSA poll conducted for WXIA-TV in Atlanta, WMAZ-TV in Macon, and for Roll Call, the newspaper of Capitol Hill. Chambliss wins 53% to 36% to 8% today, backed by a broad coalition of men and women, young and old, Republicans and Independents, less educated and more educated, and voters in Northwest, Southern and Eastern GA. Democratic challenger Martin runs comparatively strongest in Greater Atlanta, among voters focused on the Economy, and among Moderates. 3rd-Party candidate Buckley receives 22% of Independent votes, 11% of the votes of those under age 50, and 24% of those who rarely go to church. Buckley appears to take more votes from Martin than Chambliss. To the extent Buckley's support collapses closer to Election Day, the contest between Chambliss and Martin could be closer than shown here.

Obama Has Few Points of Traction in Peachtree State: In an election for President of the United States in Georgia today, 09/18/08, seven weeks until votes are counted, Republican John McCain defeats Democrat Barack Obama 57% to 41%, according to a SurveyUSA poll conducted for WXIA-TV in Atlanta, and for Roll Call, the newspaper of Capitol Hill. McCain leads 3:1 among white voters. Obama leads 23:1 among black voters. McCain leads by double digits among both men and women, among those under age 50 and those age 50+, among the less educated and the more educated, among those who earn more than \$50K/year, and in all parts of Georgia outside of greater Atlanta. Obama runs comparatively strongest among Moderates, where he is up 5, in greater Atlanta, where he is up by 5, among Pro-Choice voters, where he is up by 14, among lower-income voters, where he and McCain tie, among voters focused on the Economy, where he trails McCain by 3, and among voters who think alternative sources of energy are more important than off-shore drilling, where he leads McCain 2:1.

Approval Ratings: Among likely voters in Georgia: Chambliss is viewed favorably by 46%, unfavorably by 22%, for a Net Rating of Plus 24.

Martin is viewed favorably by 31%, unfavorably by 23%, for a Net Rating of Plus 8.

McCain is viewed favorably by 54%, unfavorably by 31%, for a Net Rating of Plus 23.

Obama is viewed favorably by 41%, unfavorably by 48%, for a Net Rating of Minus 7.

13% approve of the job the US Congress is doing.

41% approve of the job President George W. Bush is doing.

41% say oil companies are most responsible for the price of gasoline, followed by 15% who say the President is responsible, followed by 13% who say Congress.

Filtering: SurveyUSA interviewed 900 Georgia adults 09/14/08 through 09/16/08. Interviews were conducted after federal bailout of Fannie Mae had been announced and as the bankruptcy of Lehman Brothers and federal bailout of AIG were unfolding. Of the adults, 798 were registered to vote. Of the registered voters, 684 were determined by SurveyUSA to be likely voters in the 11/04/08 general election. Georgia has 15 Electoral College votes. George W. Bush carried Georgia by 17 points in 2004 and by 12 points in 2000.

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Statement of Methodology: The following statement conforms to the principles of disclosure of the National Council on Public Polls: How this poll was conducted: This SurveyUSA poll was conducted by telephone in the voice of a professional announcer. Respondent households were selected at random, using Random Digit Dialed (RDD) sample provided by Survey Sampling, of Fairfield CT. All respondents heard the questions asked identically. Within the report, you will find: the geography that was surveyed; the date(s) interviews were conducted and the news organization(s) that paid for the research. The number of respondents who answered each question and the margin of sampling error for each question are provided. Where necessary, responses were weighted according to age, gender, ethnic origin, geographical area and number of adults and number of voice telephone lines in the household, so that the sample would reflect the actual demographic proportions in the population, using most recent U.S. Census estimates. In theory, with the stated sample size, one can say with 95% certainty that the results would not vary by more than the stated margin of sampling error, in one direction or the other, had the entire universe of respondents been interviewed with complete accuracy. There are other possible sources of error in all surveys that may be more serious than theoretical calculations of sampling error. These include refusals to be interviewed, question wording and question order, weighting by demographic control data and the manner in which respondents are filtered (such as, determining who is a likely voter). It is difficult to quantify the errors that may result from these factors. Fieldwork for this survey was done by SurveyUSA of Clifton, NJ.
