Republicans by 6 to 1 Say Trump Has Stabilized the Middle-East;
 Democrats by 11 to 1 Say Trump Has De-Stabilized the Middle East

82% of Voters Nationwide Say US Senate Should Call Witnesses at Impeachment Trial of Donald John Trump; 28% Expect Senate Trial To Be Fair, 60% See Bias Dead-Ahead; Just 16% Say McConnell Should Allow POTUS to Prevent Bolton and Others from Testifying Using Immunity Claim:

By 9 to 1, Americans nationwide say the United States Senate should allow witnesses with first-hand knowledge of President Donald John Trump's words and deeds to testify at Trump's impeachment trial, which begins tomorrow 01/21/20, according to SurveyUSA's latest polling.

93% of Democrats, 81% of Independents, and 71% of Republicans say witnesses should not be prevented from testifying. If the President attempts to block testimony with claims of executive privilege or immunity, 46% of Americans say the US Senate should insist that the witnesses testify; 29% say that the US Senate should ask the Supreme Court of the United States to intervene; just 16% say in such an event, the Senate should reach a verdict without witnesses (32% of Republicans compared to 5% of Democrats).

3 times since October 2019, SurveyUSA has asked registered voters nationwide whether the US Senate should convict President Trump in a trial "today," or find President Trump not guilty. Though the pile of publicly available evidence continues to grow, little of it favorable to the President, nationwide consensus has not budged. Today 01/21/20, 46% of registered voters nationwide say the US Senate should vote to convict, based on the evidence in the public domain. This compares to 49% nationwide in November 2019 and 47% nationwide in October 2019. Today, 39% say the Senate should find the president **not** guilty. This compares to 42% in November and 40% in October. Among self-identified independents, the percent who say the Senate should convict has eroded from 46% in October to 44% in November to 40% today. By 2 to 1, Americans say the United States was justified in killing an Iranian general. Republicans are 12 times more likely to say the missile attack on Qasem Soleimani was justified than are Democrats. 3 of 4 nationwide expect Iran to retaliate further, beyond the attacks of US air bases in Iraq which promptly followed the roadside bombing in Baghdad.

26% nationwide say President Trump's words and deeds have helped to stabilize the Mideast, 41% say Trump has helped to de -stabilize the Mideast.

The percentage of Americans who say President Trump's mental health is excellent is stable at 19%. The percent of Americans who say President Trump's mental health is poor is stable at 41%.

About : SurveyUSA interviewed 5,000 adults nationwide 01/14/20 through 01/16/20, immediately following the Democratic Party candidate debate 01/14/20 in Iowa. Of the adults, 4,069 are registered to vote and were asked the substantive questions in this survey. The research was conducted online. As is true with any opinion research report, the fewer the individual respondents in the sub-population, the larger the chance that sampling error and other error may make those estimates less precise.

Statement of Methodology: SurveyUSA is an independent, non-partisan, apolitical research company that conducts opinion surveys for media, academic institutions, commercial clients, non-profits, governments, agencies, and elected officials. SurveyUSA opinion research is conducted using a methodology optimized for each particular project. In some cases, this means data is collected 100% by telephone; in some cases, 100% online; and in other cases, a blend of the two. For those projects that are conducted "mixed-mode" (or "multi-mode"): Respondents who have a home (landline) telephone are interviewed by phone, sometimes using live interviewers, other times using the recorded voice of a professional announcer. The youngest male is requested on approximately 30% of calls to home phones, the youngest adult is requested on approximately 70% of calls. This method of intra-household selection reduces the potential for age and gender imbalance in the unweighted sample. Re-attempts are made to busy signals, no-answers, and answering machines. Landline telephone sample is purchased from Aristotle of Washington DC. Respondents who do not use a home telephone are interviewed on an electronic device, which means, for some projects, that call-center employees hand-dial cell phones and interview respondents verbally on the respondent's cell phone, and means, for other projects, that SurveyUSA displays the questions visually on the respondent's phone, tablet, or other device. Sample for respondents who do not use a home telephone is purchased from Aristotle or from one of several other research companies that provide access to cell respondents. Where meaningful, SurveyUSA indicates the percentage of respondents who use a home phone and the percentage who do not, and crosstabs by this distinction. Responses are minimally weighted to U.S. Census or voter file targets for gender, age and race. Target (cell) weighting is used. On questionnaires that ask about political party identification, SurveyUSA may or may not weight to Party ID, depending on client preference. Where necessary, questions and answer choices are rotated to prevent order bias, recency, and latency effects. On some studies, certain populations are over-sampled, so that the number of unweighted respondents exceeds the number of weighted respondents. Each individual SurveyUSA release contains the date(s) on which interviews are conducted and a release date. If interviewing for a particular study is conducted in Spanish, or in any other foreign language, it will be noted on the specific release. If no notation appears, interviews are conducted in English. Where respondents are filtered, such as adults, filtered to registered voters, in turn filtered to likely voters, SurveyUSA describes the filtering on the specific release. On pre-election polls in geographies with early voting, SurveyUSA differentiates between respondents who have already voted and those who are likely to vote but have not yet done so. On research completed prior to 12/31/16, SurveyUSA assigned to each question within the instrument a theoretical margin of sampling error. Effective 01/01/17, SurveyUSA assigns to each question within the instrument a credibility interval, which better reflects the sampling uncertainties associated with gathering some percentage of respondent answers using non-probability sample. Though commonly cited in the presentation of research results, "sampling error" is only one of many types of error that may influence the outcome of an opinion research study. More practical concerns include the way in which questions are worded and ordered, the inability to contact some, the refusal of others to be interviewed, and the difficulty of translating each questionnaire into all possible languages and dialects.
